



GRAHAM'S 1963 SINGLE HARVEST

Vintage Tawny Port | The Artisan

This beautiful and rare Graham's 1963 Single Harvest Tawny Port, nicknamed "The Artisan", was aged 55 years in seasoned oak cask before being bottled in 2018. Bottled from Cask# 3 and producing only 676 bottles, this is a true rarity and a chance to taste a rare product of this age. Graham's produces outstanding Vintage Ports, aged in bottle and Tawny Port, aged in oak casks. This Old Tawny Port epitomizes Graham's hallmark complexity, elegance and balance. The wine was made from grapes grown at Quinta dos Malvedos in Douro Valley in northern Portugal.

Tasting notes

Color

Intense, deep amber color.

Taste

This exquisite multi-layered wine reveals delicate citrus aromas with hints of honeysuckle, black tea and fennel. It is smooth as silk on the palate, showing hints of almonds and walnuts, fruitcake and a soft toffee undertone with a slight minty edge.

Finish

The finish is unctuous and long with a lingering, exquisite aftertaste.
