Resting undisturbed for 30 years in the same cask allowed the spirit to evolve into a luxurious, naturally dark, single malt whisky characterized by its rich flavours of dried fruits, orange and spice.

Rich sherry, with orange clove, nutmeg and wood smoke.

Deliciously smooth, with dried fruits, sherry, orange and wood smoke.

Long and rich, with orange and spice.
